

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company, under the name of the Washington County Bank, in the Town of Williamsport, in Washington county, which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, and being accordingly engrossed,

Mr. Pigman from the committee on insolvency, to which was referred the bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Francis Jones, of the City of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The resolution relative to the Free School Fund, was read the third time, and the question was put,

“Shall the resolution be assented to?”
