It was then read the second, and special order the third

time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wootton presented the petition of Richard Duvall, praying for certain relief, which was read and referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Calvert county, to levy a sum of money for the repairing or opening a road in said county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act entitled, an act for draining a marsh and branch known by the name of the Long Marsh, lying in Queen Anne's and Caroline counties, passed at November session 1789, chapter 15, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the preservation of fish in Allegany county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent any clerk of the court of appeals, or any auditor in chancery in this state, from practising law as an attorney, in any of the courts of common law or equity in this state, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the amendments proposed by the house of delegates to the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act entitled, an act for quieting possessions,
