property; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, an act for draining part of a branch of Tuckahoe, known by the name of German's Branch, lying in Queen Anne's county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Page and Hughlett.

A bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act of December session 1827 chapter 117, entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled an act to alter the time of holding the election of electors of the senate of Maryland; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Page, Hughlett and Mayer.

On motion of Mr. Page, the bill entitled, an act relating to coroners, was recommitted to Messrs. Page, Hughlett and

Claude.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to authorise the governor and council of Maryland to appoint the inspectors of flour for this state, passed at December fession 1825, chapter 174, was read the third time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Page from the committee to which was recommitted the bill entitled, an act relating to coroners, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to.

Amendments proposed.

In the 3d line of the 1st sec. strike out the words 'Dorchester county' and insert the words 'in the state of Maryland.'

In the 6th line of the 1st sec after the word 'except' insert the words 'where the said person died in jail or.'

In the 5th line of the 2d sec. strike out the words 'said county' and insert the words 'the county where the person shall have been tound.'

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.
