The bill entitled, an act relating to coroners.

The bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed from Grafton Duvall and Elizabeth W Duvall his wife, to Alexander Thomas Hawkins Duvall, and

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of Francis Jones of Baltimore, severally passed by the same on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to abolish the office of clerk commissioner of the tax for Charles county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the establishment of public free schools in the first electon distict in Baltimore county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment, which was read and assented to.

In the 4th line of the 4th section, strike out the words 'previously or subsequently made' and insert the words 'made or occurring in any assessments made or to be made before or after the passage of this act.'

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, to which was referred a resolution in favor of Sarah Auld,

A resolution in favor of John Eisell, and

A resolution in favor of Claudius Legrand, reported favorably thereon.

They were then severally read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the hoase of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Osborn, the bill entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Commercial Bank of Millington in Kent county, was
