

In the 7th line of the 16th section after the word 'property' insert the words 'other than warehouses and quarries.'

In the same line strike out the words 'such land and materials' and insert the word 'same.'

In the 14th line of the same section after the word 'materials' insert the words 'as before described.'

At the end of the 16th section add:

'Provided always, that no timber shall be cut on any land other than the bed of the rail road company by order of the said rail road company, or taken by them for the use of said road without the consent of the owners, except from said bed.

The bill was then read through the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

Mr. Forrest, (President,) appeared in the senate chamber and took the chair.
