Mr. Dennis from the committee on finance, to which was referred a bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act concerning crimes and punishments, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to the opening of Bottle Alley in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment, which was read and assented to.

At the end of the bill add:

‘And provided, that in the ordinance which the mayor and city council shall pass by virtue and in pursuance of this act, provision shall be made for a trial by jury in any case of such appeal, at the instance of the appellant or appellants in the particular case of appeal.’

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act relating to the grade of the square of Washington Monument in the city of Baltimore, was read the third time by special order and passed.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 o'clock.
