

2d. In the 4th line of the 4th section strike out the word 'three' and insert the word 'two.'

3d. Add as an additional section of the bill to come in as the 7th section.

'And be it enacted, That any money, bank notes or chattel property employed, used or attempted to be used or introduced within or about the buildings, yard or enclosures of the penitentiary of this state, for the purpose of rescuing or procuring the release of any convict confined in said penitentiary, shall be forfeited thereby to the use of this state, and the directors of said penitentiary may and shall take possession thereof, and appropriate the same by sale or otherwise to the use of this state in the business of said penitentiary, and they shall institute and prosecute any suit or suits in the name of the state, that may by them be deemed or found necessary for the recovery or forfeiture of such money, bank notes or property; provided always, that nothing in this act contained shall be construed so as to forfeit any money, bank notes or property heretofore so introduced or employed and not then forfeitable, but the said directors may in their discretion deliver the same to any person or persons whom they shall think best entitled thereto, or to his, her or their attorney.'

Mr. Pigman from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution in favor of William Caton, reported favorably thereon.

It was then read the second, and by special order the third time and assented to.

Mr. Dennis from the committee on invalid deeds to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorize the recording of certain deeds therein mentioned for the benefit of John Norris, of Frederick county,

And the bill entitled, an act to authorize the recording of a deed from Magdalena Seibert and Jacob Seibert to Samuel Bentz, of Washington county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion they ought not to pass.

They were then severally read the second, and by special order the third time and rejected.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act to restrain private banking, was taken up for consideration, and
