The bill entitled, an act relating to imprisonment for debtors on judgments of justices of the peace, being entitled to a second reading, was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the following amendment was read and assented to.

In the 9th line of the 1st section, strike out the word "ten" and insert the word "fifteen."

The bill was then read through, and the question was put "shall the bill be engrossed for a third reading?"

It was determined in the negative.

So the bill was rejected.

The bill entitled, an act further to amend the act to incorporate the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, being entitled to a third reading, was taken up for consideration and whilst progressing in the reading,

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the following amendments were read and assented to.

In the 6th line of the 1st section, strike out the words "the sum of" and insert the words "a sum not exceeding."

In the last line of the same section, strike out the word "and" and insert the word "or."

In the last line of the same section, after the word "imprisonment" insert the words "or both."

On motion of Mr. Wootton, the following amendments were read and assented to.

In the 3rd line of the 2nd section, strike out the words "they" and "deem" and after the word "may" insert the word "be"

In the 4th line after the word "thereto" in the same section, strike out to the word "thereof" inclusive in the 5th line.
