

Mr. Wootton from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the revaluation and reassessment of the real and personal property in Prince George's county, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution relative to the digest of the insolvent laws, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the following bills which originated in the senate, severally endorsed 'will pass.'

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the public printing of the state,

And a bill entitled, an act for opening and increasing the width of German Lane in the city of Baltimore.

Also the following bill which originated in the senate, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act concerning the judgments and judicial proceedings of the courts of justice in this state, and to provide for the completion of the records in certain cases passed at December session 1817, chapter 119; endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendment.'

The said amendment, which was as follows, was read and assented to.

Strike out from the word 'execution' in the 5th line to the word 'it' in the 6th line of the 1st section.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein named, heretofore returned from the house of delegates endorsed 'the proposed amendments of the senate agreed to with the proposed amendment,' was reconsidered, and the said proposed amendment, which was as follows, assented to.

Strike out the words 'chattels real excepted,' at the end of the 6th section.

The bill was then read as amended, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.
