

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which the petition was referred reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Manufacturers and Mechanics Savings Company of Baltimore, which was read the first time.

Mr. Mayer submitted the following message.

By the Senate,

March 12, 1832.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The bill to incorporate the Mechanics Savings Fund Society of Baltimore was passed by the senate with the following amendments, which however it appears were accidentally omitted to be sent with the bill when it was returned to your honorable body. The amendments were as follows.

In the 3d line of the 2d section strike out the word 'February' and insert the word 'April.'

In the 6th line of the 2d section strike out the word 'February' and insert the word 'April.'

In the 3d line of the 6th section after the word 'deposits' insert the words 'of any member.'

At the end of the bill add the following section:

'And be it enacted, That full power to annul the charter hereby granted is reserved.'

In consequence of the omission we have mentioned, we respectfully submit to you the propriety of reconsidering the bill, and as it returned to your honorable body, with the amendments we have specified.

After the word 'Wicomico' in the bill insert the words 'and in Patuxent river.'

In the title of the bill after the words 'Potomac river' insert the words 'and Patuxent river.'

The question was then put,

"Shall the bill pass."
