

ries and taverns, and may exercise a sound discretion relative thereto, and in the recess of the said courts the several judges thereof shall have the said power and authority, and in such recess the judges of the orphans courts at their several sessions shall and may exercise the like authority and discretion of withdrawing such license; and no license to retail ardent spirits or to any ordinary or tavern shall hereafter be granted except by order or under authority of said county courts or Baltimore city court at their sessions, or of the several judges thereof in the recess of such courts.
