

3d. In the 7th section (relating to payment of services of the commissioners) after the word 'commissioners' insert 'or by the said clerk of said commissioners.'

Also the following bills which originated in the senate, severally endorsed 'will pass.'

A bill entitled, an act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Maryland State Colonization Society.

Also the following bills which originated in the senate severally endorsed 'will not pass.'

A bill entitled, a supplement (as concerns the city of Baltimore) to the act entitled, an act to provide a summary mode of recovering the possession of lands and tenements holden by tenants for years or at will after the expiration of their terms.

A bill entitled, an act to exempt from taxation the building and ground of the Baltimore Athenaeum.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of the citizens of Maryland holding persons of color for a term of years, and to prevent their absconding.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to actions of replevin passed at December session 1825, chapter 65.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Sam's Creek Rail Road Company, reported favorably thereon.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Chapman from the committee on finance to which was referred a resolution relative to paying the funeral expenses of Doctor Taney,

A resolution relative to the public printing,

A resolution in favor of Andrew Slicer and John Quynn,

A resolution in favor of William Hughlett,

And a resolution in favor of William M'Neir, reported favorably thereon.
