Mr. Page from the committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Savings Institution of Dorchester county, reported favorably thereon. It was read the second, and by special order the third time, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Dennis from the committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce George Carey, of Worcester county from his wife Nancy Carey, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and a majority of the committee were of opinion it ought to pass. It was then read the second time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee, to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to repeal an act entitled, an act for the encouragement of an Iron Manufacture, within this province, which was read the first time.

Mr. Hughlett submitted the following order, which was read and adopted:

Ordered, that Messrs. Hughlett and Wootton, be a committee to inform the House of Delegates that the governor elect, attends in the Senate Chamber for the purpose of qualifying according to the constitution, and to request the attendance of the members of that house.
