part of Scott street, and a part of Dawson Alley, in the city of Baltimore, which was read the first and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Andrew Hook, late of the city of Baltimore, was read the third time, by special order, passed and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer submitted the following order, which was read and adopted:

Ordered, that the senate now proceed to the election of a director on the part of the state, in the Bank of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, George C. Morton, was put in nomination, the senate then proceeded to ballot, the ballot box being prepared, the ballots were deposited therein, and on examination thereof, by the clerk, it appeared there had been nine votes given, all of which were for George C. Morton.

Whereupon it was declared that George C. Morton is duly elected a director on the part of the state in the Bank of Baltimore, for and during the present year.

Mr. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Dorchester county, to purchase a piece of land for the repairs of a public causeway in said county, reported tavorably thereon. It was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Eastern Savings Company, being entitled to a second reading, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading, on motion of Mr. Morris, the following amendments were read and adopted: In the 22nd line of the first section, strike out all after the word "act." At the end of the 5th section add: Provided that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to confer authority on the directors or stockholders by any rule or by-law, to restrict or limit the number of weekly depositors, who may desire to deposite or become members of said corporation, provided the amount paid by each depositor be not less than the sum of one dollar per week, and that they in all things comply with the
