the passage of this act, nor shall the said Sarah Block be entitled in any manner to have or claim any right, title, or interest in the estate, real, personal, or mixed of the said Arthur M. Block, that shall be acquired by him after the passage of this act.

The said amendment was read the second time and adopted; the bill was then read the second time.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Washington county, to levy a sum of money for building a bridge over Little Antietam Creek, in said county, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Montgomery and Page.

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a new road in Frederick and Baltimore counties, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Sappington and Claude,

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate entitled, an act to authorise the closing up of a part of Scott street, and a part of Dawson Alley, in the city of Baltimore, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were read and adopted, and were as follows:

1st. In the 6th line of the 3d section, strike out the words, "two or more," and insert "all the daily."

2nd. At the end of the 3d section, add the following; "The expense of the said advertisement to be paid by the party or parties, who may apply for the passage of the said ordinance or ordinances."

Also the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Eastern Savings Company, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were read and adopted, and were as follows:

1st. Insert after the word "place," in the 2nd section, 13th line, the following:

"Provided that such election shall be made within one month from the expiration of the time for which the proceding directors shall have been elected."
