

After the word "next," in the 2nd line of the 2nd section, insert the words, "or at any other time the company may think proper within the space of one year."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, and passed.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following resolution:

A resolution in favor of Levin Willen, senior, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Annapolis Savings Fund, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Claude, Dennis and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of William C. Weatherby, of Baltimore county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled an act for building a bridge across the Little Falls of Gunpowder, near Balden's Mill, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Page and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act to confirm the proceedings of the president and managers of the Somerset Manufacturing Company, and to amend the style of the corporation, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Savings Institution at Ellicott's Mills, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Dennis and Claude.

Mr. Wootton presented the memorial of the visitors and governors of St. John's College, which was read and referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a new road in Frederick and Baltimore counties, reported favorably thereon. Which was read the second, and by special order the third time, and passed.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning, 10 o'clock.
