 first time, and referred to the committee on internal im-

provement, an act to authorize the commissioners
 of Washington county, to appoint three persons to
 examine with persons herein named, and other per-
 sons herein mentioned, which was read the first time,
 and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Morris and Dennis.

Bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road in

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Cassandra G. Brien,
 of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Hugh
 Brien, which was read the first time, and referred to

 granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the
 Federal Insurance Company of Maryland, which was
 read the first time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceed-

 attachment and execution for debt, which was read the
 first time.

Mr. Claude from the committee on insolvency, to
 which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the re-
 lief of William C. Weatherby, of Baltimore county, re-
 ported favorably thereon.

Mr. Morris from the committee, to which was refer-
 red the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco
 Savings Institution, in Baltimore, which reported that the
 committee had had said bill under consideration, and
 were of opinion it ought to pass, with the following
