Laws, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on the library.

A resolution in favor of Sally Hillman, which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

A resolution requiring the treasurer of the Western Shore to pay his excellency the governor, the sum of money therein mentioned, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

Also a bill entitled, an act to diverce Sarah Gilmor, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband David S. Barnum, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Hughlett and Emory.

And returned the bill, which originated in the Senate entitled, an act to authorise the court of Dorchester county, to make valid the sale of certain real estate to Anthony Thompson, by commissioners therein named, en dorsed, "will pass."

Mr. Claude from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to extend the provisions of the act of assembly, passed at December session, 1829, chapter 147, entitled an act for the relief of Duncan Stone of Kent county, (an alien) reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to amend certain acts therein mentioned, and for other purposes, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The resolution authorising the register of the land office to issue a patent to Elisha Wright, on two certificates of resurvey, was read the third time, as heretofore amended, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the bill entitled an act to amend certain acts therein mentioned, and for other purposes, was read the third time by special order, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.
