And the bill entitled, an act to confirm an act passed at December session, 1831, chapter 232, altering and amending the constitution of this state, so far as relates to election districts in Baltimore county, also passed by the Senate on yesterday, were returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Emory, the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act passed at December session, 1829, entitled an act to provide for the election of the levy court of Queen Anne's county, by the people, was read the third time by special order, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Page the committee to which was referred the petition of the directors of the Commercial Bank of Millington, in Kent county, was enlarged and made to consist of Messrs. Page, Emory, Morris, Osborne and Claude.

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of the order of the day, being the bill entitled, an act to abolish imprisonment for debt on certain judgments, rendered by justices of the peace, passed at December session, 1830, chapter 155, when

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the consideration of said bill was further postponed, and

On motion of Mr. Pigman, it was made the order of the day, for Monday next, the 18th inst.

Mr. Morris from the committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Sarah Anne Stansbury of the City of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment, which was read and assented to.

In the 1st section strike out the words "*a vinculo matrimonii*," and insert the words, "bed, board, and mutual cohabitation with her."
