Mr. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the incorporation of Dorchester Lodge, No. 19, of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Morris, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Snuff Mill Company, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the third reading,

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the following amendments were read and assented to:

In the 7th line of the 2d section strike out the word "qther," and insert the word "lease."

In the 10th line of the 2nd section, after the word "chattels," insert the words "necessary for the operation of said work."

In the 2nd line of the 11th section strike out the word "sixty," and insert the words "fifty three."

Add the following as an additional section:

"And be it enacted, That the affairs, books and circumstances of said company shall at all times be subject to the inspection of the treasurer of the western shore, or such other person as may be appointed by either branch of the general assembly for the time being."

The bill was then read through the third time and passed.
