Which were read and assented to.

Strike out the following words in the 7th line of the bill: "but shall not," and in lieu thereof insert the words "and shall."

At the end of the bill add the following clause:

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the resolution in favor of Joshua Guyton was read the third time by special order assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Morris leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to amend the charter of the city of Baltimore so that the mayor may be immediately elected by the people without the intervention of electors.

Ordered, That Messrs. Morris, Montgomery and Hughlett be a committee to prepare and report the same.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Warran Manufacturing Company, being entitled to a third reading, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading

On motion of Mr. Morris, the following amendment was read and assented to:

In the 4th line of the 1st section, strike out the word "March" and insert the word "April."

The bill was then read through and passed.

Was read the third time by special order, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.
