nevertheless, that the mutual deeds to be executed under this act, shall be made, acknowledged and recorded according to the laws of this state in such cases made and provided."

Mr. Dennis from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution in favor of James Jones, of

Baltimore county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time, and

On Motion of Mr. Pigman, ordered to lie on the table. Mr. Dennis from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution in favor of John B. Armstead of Virginia, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the House of Dele-

gates.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the General Insurance Company of Maryland, was read the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

On Motion of Mr. Dennis, the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 323, was enlarged and made to consist of Messrs. Dennis, Emory, Wootton, Morris and Montgomery.

On Motion of Mr. Morris leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Canton Company of Baltimore,

passed December session, 1828, chapter 159.

Ordered that Messrs. Morris, Dennis and Montgom-

ery be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Morris, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled a further supplement to the act authorising the appointment of inspectors and wood corders in the city of Baltimore.

Ordered that Messis, Morels, Mayer and Dennis be a

committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled an act to incorporate the Central Savings Institution of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Morris from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Canton Company of Baltimore, passed at December session 1628, chapter 159, which was read the first time.
