timore Company, being entitled to a third reading, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading,

On motion of Mr. Morris the following amendment was read and assented to.

At the end of the 1st section add the following:

"And the authority to held land, shall not be so construed as to authorise said company, to held or purchase lands in any other part of this state, except Baltimore city and county."

The bill was then read through, and the question was put 'shall the bill pass?"

It was determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceeding, to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an act granting appeals from the court of chancery and from the several county courts as courts of equity.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Pigman submitted the following report, which was read the first time.

The committee upon insolvency, liave had the petition of Alfred Lee, under consideration, and beg leave to report, that it would be inexpedient, and might be highly injurious to creditors to pass the law prayed for by the petitioner. The committee therefore recommend that the petitioner have leave to withdraw his petition, and the committee be discharged from any further consideration on the subject of said petition.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Chatsworth Water Company, being entitled to a third reading was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading,

On motion of Mr. Morris the following amendment was read and assented to:

In the 4th line of the 1st section, strike out "March," and insert "April."

On motion of Mr. Pigman the following amendment was read and assented to:

In the 4th line, 15th section, strike out the word "necessary," and insert the word "privy," and after the word "or," strike out the word "other."
