A bill entitled, an act to repeal part of an act passed December session 1824, chapter 167, authorising gates to be kept on the public roads in Queen Anne's County;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Page, Hughlett and Osborn.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Amanda Christiana Armstrong of Saint Mary's County;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Claude and Groome.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of George M. Tyler of the city of Frederick, in Frederick County, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act relating to private wharves, docks and the like in the city of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment;"

Which amendment was read and adopted, and was as follows:
