

TUESDAY, February 26, 1833.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the conveyance of certain real estate therein mentioned, passed by the senate with certain amendments on yesterday, was returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany, being entitled to a second reading, was taken up for consideration, and whilst progressing in the reading,

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the following amendments were read and assented to.

At the end of the 2nd section add the following, "subject however, to the provisions of this act."

In the 10th line of the third section, strike out the word "May" and insert "April." Fill the blanks in the 3rd section with the word "four."

On motion of Mr. Mayer the following amendment was read and assented to.

Strike out the 4th section and insert,

"And be it enacted, That on all judgments of said bank obtained by said commissioners, which now remain unsatisfied, or in discharge of which property has been purchased, the said commissioners shall be allowed a commission not exceeding three per cent, (that is one per cent each) upon the amount of said judgements, as some one or more of the judges of the fifth judicial district shall determine to be reasonable, and that on said commission being paid, or secured to be paid to said commissioners, all books, papers and property, real, personal and mixed, belonging to said bank shall be delivered to the president and directors of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany, for the time being for the benefit of the stockholders, and the said books, papers and property, real, personal and mixed, shall be delivered over accordingly by said commissiners, so far as the same may be in their hands or possession, and thereupon the power, authority and responsibility of said commissioners shall cease and be at end, but not otherwise."
