

A resolution in favor of Stephen Fennell of the state of Ohio, reported favorably thereon.

Mr. Pigman from the committee on insolvency to which was referred the petition of William S. Jenkins, reported a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of William S. Jenkins of the city of Baltimore.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and on motion of

Mr. Pigman read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act passed at November session 1802, chapter 81, to make public the proceedings of the levy courts in the several counties of this state and for other purposes, so far as relates to Washington county, reported favorably thereon.
