

Insert the following as sections 8th and 9th.

'Section 8th. *And be it enacted,* That every subscriber shall pay to the above named directors, who shall attend for opening the books at the time of subscribing for the same, the sum of five dollars on each share that shall be by him subscribed, and each subscriber shall within sixty days thereafter, pay such further sum on each share as the president and directors may require, not exceeding seven dollars and fifty cents; and the remainder on each share shall be paid by such instalments, and at such times as the directors shall appoint, upon giving not less than three months notice of such demand in the most public places in the county, and in such newspaper or newspapers, as they may think proper, and receipts shall be given for the several payments so made; but when a subscriber shall have paid the second instalment on each share, such subscriber shall be entitled to receive a certificate, under the seal of the bank, and subscribed by the president for the number of shares by him or her held.

Sec. 9. *And be it enacted,* That it shall and may be lawful for said bank, to discount any bills of exchange or promissory notes, which shall be offered for discount in said bank, by any person or persons, although the same shall not on the face thereof be made negotiable at the Commercial Bank of Millington, nor be made payable at the house of any person in Millington, and that the same shall be recoverable by said bank in any court of law or equity, and be good and valid to all intents and purposes.'

The bill was then read though and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act respecting appeals in cases of issues sent for trial from orphans' courts.

Was read the second time, and ordered to be angrossed for a third reading.
