

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to incorporate the Allegany Improving Company.

Ordered, That Messrs. Mayer, Pigman and Dennis be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity, passed at December session 1831, chapter 311.

Ordered, That the committee on judicial proceedings prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the manner of holding and transmitting the title to certain church property therein mentioned.

Ordered, That the committee on judicial proceedings prepare and report the same.

The bill entitled, an act relating to the importation of passengers, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
