A resolution in favor of Solomon Shearman, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A resolution in favor of Peddicord Eaip, of Anne-Arundel county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on pensions ann revolutionary claims.

A resolution in favor of Samuel Harrison, (of William,) which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A resolution in favor of Moses Orme, of Anne Arundel county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

A resolution in favor of Anne Martin, of Prince-George's county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

A resolution in favor of William Jones, of Caroline county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Edward W. Belt, of Prince-George's county, which was read the first time and referred to Messes. Wootton, Pigman and Dennis.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Lucinda Rodgers, of Allegany county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Page and Mayer.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to authorise the governor and council to appoint directors of the banks therein mentioned, endorsed "will not pass."

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the following order was read and adopted:

Ordered, That a resolution which was erroneously endorsed and by mistake sent by the house of delegates to the senate on Friday the first of this instant, purporting to be an appropriation of three hundred dollars for the use of the library, be returned to that house in conformity with their message.

On motion of Mr. Mayer leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the dispatch of business in Baltimore county court.

Ordered, that the committee on judicial proceedings prepare and report the same.
