And the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Walter Wells, one of the securities of Thomas R. Wells, deceased, and late collector of taxes for Calvert county,

Worcester county court to record a certain deed therein mentioned, severally rejected by thesenate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Washington county bank in the town of Williamsport in Washington county

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the dispatch of business in the Baltimore county court,

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent the unreasonable delay of justice, and accumulations of unnecessary law-suits in the courts of this state, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to:

Strike outall the bill after the enacting clause, and insert as follows:

"That from and after the first day of next September, where any judgement of any county court upon any cause of action that shall thereafter accrue, shall be affirmed by the court of appeals, and it shall appear to the said court of appeals, that the appeal taken, or writ of error sued out in the cases, was taken or sued out merely for delay, mid court of appeals shall over and above the interest which by law the amount payable under, and by virtue of said judgment shall carry, award damages for the delay at the rate of four per centum per annum, on
