The bill entitled, an act granting appeals from the court of chancery and from the several county courts as courts of equity, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the valuation of real and personal property in Baltimore county, out of the limits of the city, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment: which was read and assented to.

After the word "may" in the 1st line of the 1st section add "at their discretion either appoint an additional clerk or."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and passed.

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the appointment of commissioners for taking acknowledgments of deeds, proof of instruments of writing and affidavits, in the several states of the union, was read the first time,

And on motion of Mr. Mayer amended by adding the following as an additional section:

"And be it enacted, That the said commissioner shall cause a certificate to be subjoined to his certificate, of any acknowledgment aforesaid from the clerk of a court of record under seal of such court, certifying that the person who has subscribed the said certificate is the commissioner aforemaid."

The question was then put,

Shall the bill pass?

And it was determined in the affirmative.

On motion of M1. Morris, the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act to erect Baltimore town in Baltimore county into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Pigman from the committee to which was refered the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Lucinda
