

Rodgers of Allegany county reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

After the words "*feme sole*," in the 3rd section, insert the words, "except that of marrying again during the life time of the said Arthur Rodgers."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, and passed.

The bill entitled, an act for the preservation of wild-fowl in the Potomac river and its tributary streams, was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the steam company of Princess Anne, passed at December session 1815, chapter 82,

Was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act to provide for the widening of a part of Wagon Alley in the city of Baltimore,

Was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, an act to prevent partiality in sales by auction of deceased person's estates, was taken up for consideration.

The amendment heretofore reported was read, and assented to:

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time and

The question was then put, "shall the bill pass?"

It was determined in the negative, and the bill returned to the House of Delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Horticultural Society of Maryland,

Was read the third time, and passed.

The bill entitled, an act to divorce Mary Elizabeth Stewart of the city of Baltimore, from her husband William S. Stewart,

Was read the third time as proposed to be amended, and passed.
