By the Senate,

6th March, 1833.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The great importance of the undertakings of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company and of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, urges us to promote as far as possible, such an arrangement of the conflicting views of the two companies in the prosecution of their projects as may tend to accomplish the interesting objects of each. To ascertain such plan as may be practicable for such an end, and that the general assembly may have submitted to it such expedients for its action as may effect the desired result, we have appointed as a committee upon the part of the senate, Messrs. Mayer, Emory and Pigman to join such committee as may be named by your honorable body upon the same subject.
