By the House of Delegates, March 6th, 1833.

Gentlemen of the Senate,

We have received your message proposing the appointment of a joint committee relative to the disputes existing between the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company and the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, and agree thereto. We have appointed on the part of this house Messrs. Pratt, Dudley, Harding, Duvall of Anne-Arundel, Millar, Nicols and Harris.

A bill entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Prederick county into twelve election districts, and for other purposes, passed at December session 1831, chapter 112; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Steppington, Dennis and Montgomery.
