

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Emory, Mayer and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act for the preservation of wild fowl, in the waters of Swann Creek, Spisutie Narrows, Rumney Creek, Brush River, and Gunpowder River, in Harford county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Groome and Dennis.

A bill entitled, a further additional supplementary act to the act entitled, an act to establish orphans courts in the several counties of this state, passed at February session 1777.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Emory and Mayer.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Vienna Academy.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Page, Dennis and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate a company for the purpose of making a canal to connect the water of Lewis creek, with Indian river, and the Chesapeake bay by Pocomoke river.

Which were read the first time, and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

Mr. Dennis from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was recommitted the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act of December session, 1827, chapter 117, entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others, reported that the committee had had said bill again under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to:

First amendment.

Strike out the proviso at the end of the first section, and in lieu thereof insert the following proviso:

“Provided, however that nothing in this act contained shall be construed to prohibit any person or persons, or body politic, exposing for sale, or selling any goods, wares or merchandize, without license in respect of which a license is not made necessary by the act to
