On motion of Mr. Pigman it was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of George Fouke and Elizabeth his wife, and Henry and Lewis Fouke, was ordered to lie on the table.

The senate adjourned until 5 o'clock, P. M.

The Senate met. Present the same members as in the forenoon.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to promote internal unprovement by the construction of a rail road from Baltimore to the city of Washington, passed at December session 1830, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to:

In the 8th line of the 6th section strike out the words

"ninety days" and insert the words "six months."

In the 10th section after the words "And be it enacted that" insert as follows?

"Individual subscriptions for stock in virtue of the provisions of this act shall be entitled to vote for directors of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company in the same manner as stockholders in the said Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road

Company now vote and."

At the end of the bill add the following section: "And be it enacted, That the owners of the Savage Factory, and of the factory called Johnson's Factory, and of any other factory which is or shall be established within five miles of the said rail road authorised by this act shall respectively be entitled to connect a road from their several factories to and with said road, and to erect a depot'at the point of junction, and it shall be the duty of the company to take from and deliver at said depot any produce, merchandise, manufactures, or other articles whatsoever which they may require to be transported on said road."

The said bill was then progressing in the second reading,

when

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the question was put, "Shall the bill lay on the table?"

And it was determined in the negative.
