Ordered that Messes Sappington, Pigman and Dennis be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Sappington from the said committee, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate Frederick Town in Frederick County,

Which was read the first, and by special ordered the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third read-

ing.

It was accordingly engrossed,

And on motion of Mr. Sappington read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Morris from the committee on pensions and revolutionay claims, to which was referred a resolution in favor of Peddicord Eaip of Anne Arundel County,

And a resolution in favor of Anne Martin of Prince George's County, reported that the committee had had said resolutions under consideration and were of opinion they ought not to be assented to.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, dissented from, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Morris from the said committee to which was referred a resolution in favor of James M. K. Hammitt, administrator of Thomas Lynch.

A resolution in favor of William Jones of Caroline county,

And a resolution in favor of Moses Orme of Prince George's County reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second, time, assented to, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred a bill entitled, an act to repeal an act to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Frederick County into twelve election districts and for other purposes, passed at Dec. session 1831, chapter 112, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.
