

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to blend New Town, (Trap) and Freedom, in Frederick county, in one by the name of Jefferson, and to establish boundaries of lots by commissioners, and to incorporate the same, passed December session 1831, chapter 299.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Claude and Dennis.

A bill entitled, an act to make public a road therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claude, Emory and Osborn.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise commissioners to divide Charles county into school districts.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Hughlett and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act empowering Peter Wood Crain, to complete the collections of Jesse C. Cook, deceased, late sheriff and collector of Charles county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act regulating the manner of levying on the assessable property in Anne Arundel county for the support of primary schools in said county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claude, Dennis and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Ness of the city of Baltimore from her husband Samuel Ness.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Hughlett and Groome.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Maria Barnes of the city of Baltimore from her husband Richard H. Barnes

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Hughlett and Groome.

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery, Anne Arundel and Baltimore counties.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Wootton and Piggan.
