

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to the act entitled, an act relating to the jail of Baltimore city and county, passed at December session 1831, ch. 58.

The bill entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Frederick county into twelve election districts, and for other purposes, passed at December session 1831, ch. 112.

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Cumberland Engine Company, in the town of Cumberland in Allegany county.

Was read the third time by special order, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the petition of Hester Anthony, reported a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Hester Anthony.

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Mayer read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Hughlett submitted the following message, which was read the first time:

By the Senate,

12th March, 1833.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have received your message of the 9th inst. proposing with the concurrence of the senate to suffer no new
