Mr. Woootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to alter and change the location of a public road therein mentioned, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road through, Frederick and Baltimore counties, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the inhabitants of the several primary school districts in Queen Anne's county, to levy a tax on the property in said districts, for the establishment of schools, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to:

In the 4th line of the enacting clause strike out after the word not the words "more than five hundred," and insert in place thereof the words exceeding three hundred and fifty.

In the 9th line after the word two, strike out all the residue of the section, and insert the following as a second section.

2d. section, And be it enacted, That if in any of the said primary school districts of said county, the taxable inhabitants may not have met to select a scite and vote a tax to build a school house as the act of Assembly of 1825 prescribes and directs, that they may still have power and authority to do so at any future time.

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to repeal the 6th section of the act of 1830, chapter 160, entitled an act to extend the powers of the commissioners of the school fund in Queen Anne's county, and to encourage the establishment of free schools in said county, and for other purposes, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.
