

So it was determined in the negative.

The bill was then read through, and the question was put, "Shall the bill pass?"

It was determined in the affirmative, and the bill returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further additional supplementary act to the act entitled, an act to establish orphans courts in the several counties of this state; passed at February session, 1777, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, and the question was put, "Shall the bill pass?"

It was determined in the negative, and the bill returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Hereford Savings Institution of Baltimore county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to blend New Town (Trap) and New Freedom in Frederick county, into one by the name of Jefferson and to establish boundaries of lots by commissioners and to incorporate the same, passed at December session 1831, chapter 299, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent playing long bullets in or near Creagers Town in Frederick county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Groome leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail Road Company, and to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Delaware and Maryland Rail Road Company

Ordered, that Messrs. Groome, Emory and Pigman be a committee to prepare and report the same.
