WEDNESDAY, March 13, 1833.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity, passed by the senate on yesterday, was sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Sappington, leave was given to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the West-minster and Emmitsburgh Turnpike Company.

Ordered, That Messrs. Sappington, Wootton and Pigman be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Sappington from said committee reported a bill entitled, an act relating to the Westminster, Taney town and Emmittsburgh turnpike company.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Claude from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to make public the road therein mentioned reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Claude from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act for the revaluation of the real and personal property in Anne Arundel county, passed at the present session of the general assembly, reported favorably thereon.
