It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to provide for the repairs of the public roads in Calvert county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment:
