

And returned the following bills, which originated in the Senate, severally endorsed, "will pass."

A bill entitled, an act to make valid certain records therein mentioned.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise and empower Horatio McPherson of Frederick county, the acting executor of the last will and testament of John McPherson deceased, to execute deeds and thereby to convey the legal title to certain real estate.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act for the benefit of the heirs of Mary Bucknal.

On motion of Mr. Pigman the committee on engrossed bills was enlarged and made to consist of Messrs. Page, Pigman, Dennis, Mayer, Emory, Morris, Groome and Claude.

On motion of Mr. Hughlett the resolution in favor of Anne Martin, of Prince Georges county, was reconsidered, and the question put, "Will the Senate assent to the resolution?"

It was determined in the affirmative, and the resolution returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Wootton the bill entitled, an act to alter and change the location of a public road therein mentioned.

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to regulate ferries in Somerset county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment:

In the 4th line of the 1st section, after the word "to," insert the words: "keep such ferry."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Chesapeake and Port Deposit Turnpike Road Company, passed at December session, 1827, chapter 200, reported that the com-
