

act entitled, an act for founding a College on the Western Shore of this state, and constituting the same, together with Washington College on the Eastern Shore, into one University, by the name of the University of Maryland, passed at November session 1784, chapter 37, so far as relates to Saint Mary's County,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Claude and Osborn.

A bill entitled, an act for the extension and renewal of the charter of the Farmer's Bank of Maryland and branches, and for other purposes,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Claude, Morris and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to revive the charter of the Planters' Bank of Prince George's County,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Hughlett and Page.

A bill entitled, an act for the division of Baltimore and Frederick counties, and for erecting a new one by the name of Carroll.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Claude and Emory.

And returned the following bills, which originated in the Senate, severally endorsed, "will pass."

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Toulon Company.

A bill entitled, a further supplement to an act, to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike Road from the city of Baltimore to Havre de Grace.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Trustees of the Female Orphans Society of Annapolis.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mount Hope College.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Canton Company of Baltimore, passed at December session 1828, chapter 159.

The bill entitled an act supplementary to an act to establish a Bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Commercial Bank of Millington in Kent County.
