195. An act supplementary to an act entitled, "An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of "The Commercial Bank of Millington, in Kent county."

196. A supplement to the act entitled, "An act to incorporate "The trustees of the Female Orphans Society of Annapolis."

The honorable speaker and the members of the house delegates retired.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the resolution relative to the presentation of a sword to Captain George W. Rogers, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and assented to.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act relating to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company and the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company.

Ordered, that Messrs. Mayer, Dennis, and Emory be a committee to prepare and report the same.

On motion of Mr. Wootton the bill entitled, an act to regulate fences in Somerset County was reconsidered,

And on the further motion of Mr. Wootton, the amendment heretofore assented to by the senate was read, and the question was put,

"Will the senate recede from said amendment?"

It was determined in the affirmative.

The bill was then read and passed.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred a bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Ness of the city of Baltimore, from her husband Samuel Ness reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning, 9 o'clock
