Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution relative to a geological survey.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Dennis and Pigman.

Also the following bills.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province and limiting the extent of them.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Peter Kamp of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Amelia Kamp.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Mayer and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act relating to the University of Maryland.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Claude, Mayer and Emory.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act of 1830, chapter 160, entitled, an act to extend the powers of commissioners of the school fund in Queen Anne's county, and to encourage the establishment of free schools in said county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Emory, Pigman and Osborn.

A bill entitled, an act relating to Pine street in the city of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Dennis and Mayer.
