

by order on petition or otherwise, and attachment or execution for enforcing the delivery or payment of such new trustee or trustees by the discharged trustee or trustees aforesaid, of any monies, securities, or property which said discharged trustee or trustees shall be accountable for, as such trustee or trustees, for any remedy that, without the discharge aforesaid, might have been had upon the bond or bonds in reference to said trust of such discharged trustee or trustees and their respective securities."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate entitled, a further supplement to the act to erect Baltimore town in Baltimore county, into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof, endorsed, "Will pass with the proposed amendment—which amendment was read and assented to, and was as follows:

In the 3d line, of the 2nd section, after the word 'branch' insert the words 'or in.'

On motion of Mr. Mayer the amendment proposed by the House of Delegates, to the bill entitled, an act granting appeals from the court of chancery, and from the county courts as courts of equity, was read and assented to.

On motion of Mr. Groome the bill entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail Road Company,

And to an act to incorporate the Delaware and Maryland Rail Road Company,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Groome, read the third time, passed and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Dennis from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution in favor of William McLaughlin of Allegany county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the resolution relative to a geological survey, reported favorably thereon.
