It was read the second time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company and the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for increasing the width of a part of Light Street in the city of Baltimore, reported the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment.

Which was read and assented to.

At the end of the bill add:

“And unless its provisions and all the provisions of any ordinance passed in virtue of it and in conformity thereto shall be fully complied with within two years from the passage hereof.”

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Allegany county to let out and rent certain streets and alleys lying on the west side of Will's Creek for certain purposes therein mentioned.

Was read the third time as proposed to be amended, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
