The bill entitled, an act to change the disposition of the fund appropriated to the Cumberland Academy in Allegany county.

Was read the third time rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the contributors to the Somerset Savings Institution at Princess Anne, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Emory submitted the following message:

By the Senate, March 16, 1833.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have received your message proposing to close the present session by adjournment on this day, and believing now, that we can close the session on Wednesday next, we propose with the concurrence of your honorable body that we fix on that day for the purpose of closing the session by adjournment.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Dennis from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Savings Institution of Somerset and Worcester counties at Salisbury, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment:
